THE DETAILS

The shoot is upbeat and fun. We'll do a mix of classic, modern, and fun photos along the way. We'll help you pose, laugh, and have a good time.

TIME OF DAY

Heard of the golden hour? We target 2.5 hours just before the sun fully sets. At this time, the sun is the most even and adds a natural glow. We also do early bird shoots which start just as the sun begins to rise.

THE DAY OF

- Try everything on one more time
- Iron and hang all of your clothes up on hangers
- Guys - shave or trim that facial hair (as close to the shoot as possible)

WHAT TO BRING

- All of your outfits and accessories
- Extra cosmetics including hairspray to tame those fly aways
- A comb/brush and mirror
- A bottle of water

LADIES

Be bold. Be you.

Planning what to wear can be a little overwhelming. After all Pinterest is filled with style boards, Instagram has fashion feeds, and mom, well, she has her own ideas.

OWN IT

Open shoulders, bright colors, headbands, hats, jackets, and specs, these are a few of our favorite things. When picking out your outfits, have a little fun with layers and textures. Flat fabrics and neutrals may sound like logical choices, but don't limit yourself. Look around your closet for complimentary colors or shades of the same color to bring a lot of contrast and style to your look. So go on now, find something fun.

The right accessories can go far to add interest and bring your outfit together. For a little sparkle, wear your favorite necklace, earrings, or a ring. If you like hats or scarves, bring a couple and you can interchange them throughout your session. Lastly, great shoes are a must.

YOUR HAPPY PLACE

We'll gladly scout and make recommendations on locations, but what tends to bring out the best, is a location of your own. When you're in a place that means something to you, it changes everything. You smile bigger, fall into poses easier, and are often eager to show it off.

Things to consider

- Any old barns, sheds, fields, or buildings?
- Think outside the box; music store, coffee shop, or library.
- Look for texture (brick, wood, weeds, chipped paint, or metal).

YOUR DO LIST

Do consider having your hair and makeup done, but don't overdo it, as you still want to look like you

Do try everything on, twice

Do get that underwear right. Bras and undies; do they show through, give you lines, or show straps? Wearing white? Use flesh-colored undergarments.

Do bring extra cosmetics and accessories. Powder to cut the shine, gloss for those lips, and earrings, necklaces, and bracelets to switch out.

Do drink lots of water and get plenty of rest the night before.

Do not freak about blemishes, we have software for that!







GUYS

Look great. Feel great.

We get it, picking out what to wear might not be your thing. But that doesn't mean you're off the hook. Consider our tips below and you'll do more than make your mom proud.

KEEP IT SIMPLE

Portraits are about you, not your clothes. So stick to solids and subdued patterns. Avoid those distracting big logos and words across the chest.

VARIETY OF COLORS

Dark colors and long sleeves are the most universal choices. But also pick something colorful. Not glow in the dark colorful, but something in addition to black, gray, white, tan, or navy. Do you have green eyes? Wear a dark green shirt!

A GOOD FIT

Loose fitting can often look sloppy in photos. Consider clothing that hugs you a little. Skinny guy? Try slim or skinny fit. Muscular? Grab a muscle fitted shirt, and a short sleeve to show off those guns.

CLASS IT UP

A button up, sports coat, or even a tie can take a casual photo to classy quickly. Match them to an outfit and bring them along as accessories. We'll be able to mix them so you end up with more options.

YOUR HAPPY PLACE

When you're in a place that means something to you, it changes everything. You smile bigger, fall into poses easier, and are often eager to show it off.

Things to consider

- Runner, fisherman, hunter? Think trails, streams, and fields.
- Music, reading, parkour? Think vinyl store, library, urban.
- Look for texture (brick, wood, weeds, chipped paint, or metal)

YOUR DO LIST

- Do** get a trim at least a week out.
- Do** try everything on, twice.
- Do** plan your shoes too. Pair them up with your clothes. Athletic shoes can look sloppy unless matched with athletic wear.
- Do** shave or trim just before your session. We can hide a cut, but not a face full of stubble.
- Do** bring some props if it makes you who you are. Sports equipment, hats, and instruments.
- Do** drink lots of water and get plenty of rest the night before.
- Do not** worry if you're not a photo guy, we'll still have fun, we promise.

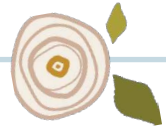

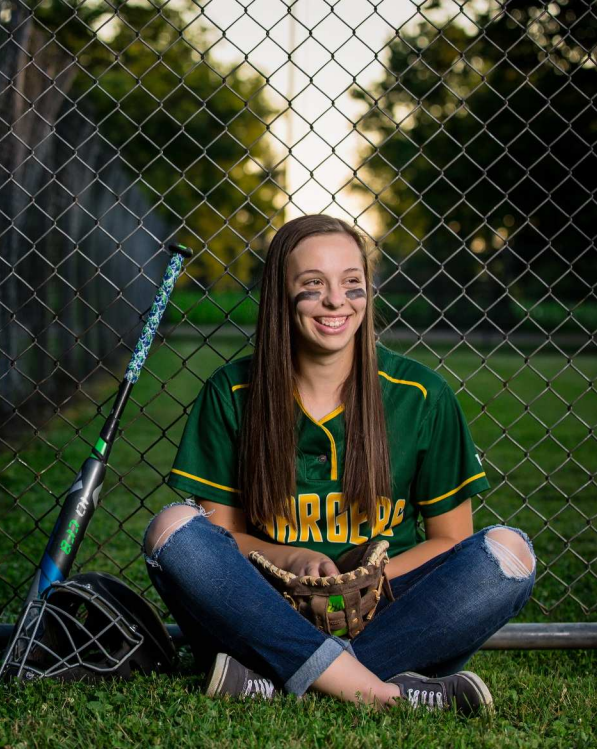
